

### Program Details: Fees

It is the policy of GPSA to work hard to ensure that the financial cost of this program is not a deterrent to participation for any student. The hospitals that need your help the most can't afford to help finance your participation. The GPSA for Health program fee allows us to send participants, medical equipment, tools and supplies to the most remote locations, thus assisting the hospitals with the greatest shortfalls. Therefore, we expect participants to share in the financial burden of this aid and we fully support them in their efforts to raise funds to pay for their program fees. The fees include:

- Pre-departure information and on-site orientation in Florida
- Transportation (transportation from host airport to homestay and back, airfare from US to Guatemala, unaccompanied minor, buses and other conveyances)
- Emergency evacuation insurance
- Housing
- Meals (three per day)
- Technical and Cultural training
- Textbooks and lab supplies
- Social Activities (cultural program)
- Field support from GPSA while in host country
- Ongoing support from GPSA US office

The fee does NOT include airfare, bus fare or car fare to the starting location. The program begins in country and ends in Ft Myers, Florida. It is each student's responsibility to arrive at the Ft Myers airport by the time stated in the program materials. However, GPSA VERY STRONGLY recommends that every student of all ages be booked as an unaccompanied minor if they are flying to Ft. Myers.

The fee does not include souvenirs or snacks. Students are encouraged to bring approximately \$1 per day of the trip to cover snacks and souvenirs.

The fee does not include obtaining a passport, travel to/from your home to the designated airport, the required immunizations\*, or the entry and exit fees for each country being visited.

The fee does not include health insurance. Participants must show evidence of health insurance including international coverage. Students without proof of international coverage will be charged an additional fee.

\* Participants must show proof of immunization for Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Tetanus (within 10 years), Typhoid and measles. Your doctor will likely recommend additional vaccinations and treatments.
