July 5, 2012 7PM: program starts at the airport in Guatemala City, Guatemala.

Program participants will be picked up from any flight that is scheduled to arrive at Guatemala City airport (GUA) on July 5 before 8PM. Students will be met at the airport arrivals area and taken to the hotel. To facilitate pickup, students should wear their GPSA T-shirt or GPSA scrub top on arrival day.
